New Perennials, Shrubs & Trees for 2024:

Perennials:

Switch Grass - Prairie Dog: More compact selection compared to the species with sturdy, upright, blue-green stems and wine-red leaves. In the spring, the foliage is blue green, but by early summer the leaves begin to turn a stunning shade of deep red. This grass is very sturdy. (4' x 2')

Aster - Showmaker Blue Bayou: This neat, compact rounded plant has deep indigo dense fully double flowers that produced over an extended period in late summer and fall. Beautiful deep green foliage. This is a great late summer pollinator plant! (12" x 15")

Geranium - Max Frei: Brilliant magenta-purple blooms stand out against the rich green, deeply lobed foliage. Blooms continuously from late spring through summer. The foliage turns crimson red in the fall. (12' x 18')

Monarda - Leading Lady Razzberry: This bee balm leads the way blooming in early summer. Flowering earlier & forming a more compact clump than other Bee Balm and it doesn't run around! The blossoms have sweet nectar that is highly attractive to butterflies, hummingbirds, and honeybees and the aromatic foliage is naturally deer resistant. (10" x 22")

Phlox - Sunset Coral: Just like the pink and orange hues that light up the sky during a sunset, 'Sunset Coral' lights up the landscape. Coral pink flowers have an orange tinge; the orange color is especially noticeable when compared with true pink *Phlox paniculata* varieties. (30" x 30")

Daylilies for 2024: Band of Fire, Blood Sweat & Tears, Born to Run, Kansas Kitten, Pink Stripes, Romantic Returns, You've Got Soul

Shrubs:

Lilac - First Editions @ Little Lady: Blooms in late spring when dark pink buds open to lilac pink fragrant flowers, contrasting against the beautiful fresh green foliage. A much improved smaller form than Miss Kim Lilac. (4' x 4')

Lilac - First Edition @ Virtual Violet®: With shiny violet trimmed new leaves, deep purple stems, raspberry-purple buds, and fragrant violet flowers upright, dense habit makes it a great choice for a hedge in smaller spaces as well as a welcome addition to foundation plantings. (6' x 5')

Rose - Marmalade Skies™ Floribunda: Flowers heavily from late spring to late fall. Form double blooms with brilliant tangerine-orange petals about 3-4" round. The flowers are ideal for making a lovely single-stemmed bouquet. Neat, compact shrub with a dense, rounded, bushy habit & very good disease resistance. (3' x 3')

Rose - The Rainbow Knockout®: With uniquely colored, coral-pink blooms with yellow centers, more compact than the other family members. New foliage first appears deep burgundy, then ages to dark green. It blooms all summer long! (3' x 3')

New Spirea for 2024: Pineapple Poprocks®, Poprocks® Petite, Rainbow Fizz™, and Yeti™...all about 2-3" x 2-3" in size. Great new little shrubs for all landscapes.

Trees:

Fire Bird Flowering Crab: This compact selection is covered with fresh white blooms in spring that mature into long-lasting, high-quality fruit. The annual fruit display is more persistent than other dwarf crabapple. Dark green leaves that have a high disease resistance. Perfect size as a specimen. (8' x 10')

Blue Arrow Juniper: An improved selection with tight, bright blue foliage and a very narrow, upright form. Perfect as a tall, narrow screen where space is limited. Makes a colorful addition to the garden. Produces silvery blue berries from late spring to late winter. (12' x 2')

Stowe Pillar Columnar Eastern White Pine: Blue green with a sturdy yet soft texture and columnar growth habit. Adds interest to those tight corners, small spaces near pathways, or flanking a front door. Stable, more compact branching compared to other narrow upright eastern white pines. (25' x 6')

We were asked and inspired to do an installation last summer that was simple yet stunning! We enhanced the beauty of our client's back alley and garage area that they see multiple times a day. Enjoying your own space is important. The design was an impactful combination of just three plants, a tall narrow juniper tree, short perennial grasses, and beautiful purple nepeta. The client chose not to use rock mulch to set it apart from the alley gravel. We used dark wood mulch to define the area.
